

2011 CHAMPS SPORTS BOWL PUBLIC SHUTTLE INFORMATION

All parking in and around the Florida Citrus Bowl will sell out prior to game day. Parking is available in downtown Orlando with a convenient express shuttle to the game.

Free public shuttles from two convenient locations:

Central Florida Fairgrounds Shuttle

Convenient to I-Drive, the Central Florida Fairgrounds offers plenty of space to tailgate or take the shuttle to join your friends at the stadium. RV hookups or RV's needing to park prior to December 29th call the Central Florida Fairgrounds at 407.295.3247

Location: 4603 West Colonial Drive, Orlando, FL

Parking Charge: \$10.00, free shuttle to the Citrus Bowl

Time: Shuttles begin running at 10:00am and run to and from the stadium throughout the day until 1 ½ hour after the game.

Drop off Location: Guest drop off and pick up at the stadium is located at the intersection of Tampa Avenue and Long Street, close to the Best Buy Fan Zone on McCracken Field.

Downtown Orlando Shuttle

This shuttle site is located in downtown Orlando, with easy access from all major highways, providing a quick ride to the Citrus Bowl. There will be signage and personnel directing to the parking lots and garages that will service this site.

Location: 600 West Amelia Street, Orlando FL

Shuttle buses will pick up at the north side of the **old Amway Arena** which is located at 600 West Amelia Street. Important! This is not the new Amway Center. A secondary downtown pickup site will be located at the Orange County Courthouse at the corner of Orange Avenue and Amelia Street.

Parking Charge: \$10.00, free shuttle to the Citrus Bowl

Time: Shuttle buses will begin running at 2:00pm and run to and from the stadium throughout the day until 1 ½ hour after the game.

Drop off Location: Guest drop off and pick up at the stadium is located at the intersection of Nashville and Church Street.

The following items are not allowed in the Florida Citrus Bowl:

- No outside food, drink
- Carts, strollers, tents, large backpacks
- Coolers, umbrellas, air horns, megaphones
- Poles longer than 12", posters larger than 11X17
- Video cameras, cameras with detachable lenses greater than 6 inches, laptops
- Pets (except assistive animals)
- Lasers or weapons/fireworks
- Unauthorized solicitation, handbills, giveaways, or sampling
